A soils engineer was contacted and it was ultimately decided that the site would be fully excavated and stone brought in to shore up the soils. Located at 993 Mill Street, the pharmacy is constructed like a vault. The walls are built with concrete block and rebar, which were then poured full of concrete. The Brindley team also fabricated and installed steel shutters over all the windows and doors for additional security.

A groundbreaking ceremony was held in April 2022 and the building was ready for occupancy by November 2022. Kudos for a job well-done to the project team of Project Manager Jeff Brindley, Project Superintendent Percy Hazelwood, Project Assistant Melissa Pierce, Emmett Smith Architects, EMC Structural Engineers, and Sain Associates Civil Engineering.

Columbia Academy Undergoes Campus-Wide Improvements

Brindley Construction recently wrapped up two projects at Columbia Academy (CA) campuses. A renovation and addition at the Spring Hill, Tennessee and Columbia, Tennessee campuses are part of CA's three-year master plan to provide the best environment for more children to learn and grow.

The 1,200-square-foot remodel and 3,000-square-foot addition at the Spring Hill campus creates four additional classrooms, adds a 6th grade space, and moves library, art, computer, and music into the building and out of a portable classroom. The Brindley team remodeled the building's restrooms prior to the beginning of the school year. The remaining work was completed in time to open after CA's fall break. A unique feature of this project is the individual HVAC units in each classroom, allowing teachers to better control the temperature in each room.

The Vest Hall 5,000-square-foot addition and 2,500-square-foot renovation at the Columbia campus expands five current classrooms while also adding four new classrooms and a new music room. The Vest Hall project proved challenging when it came time to tying into the existing structure. The original building was constructed in the 1960s so various elevation changes were required on the second floor to meet code. The Brindley team was also met with supply chain delays on steel bar joist, prompting a switch to wood framing to complete the project on time.
